Scope

This document covers the policies and procedures in cargo planning up to stuffing or loading of cargo inside a container based on set guidelines.

Definition of Terms

CBM – Cubic Meter

Ownership

The Assistant Operations Manager/ Operations Manager/ Senior Operations Manager/ Operations Head/ Assistant Vice President (AVP) – Operations is responsible for ensuring that this document is cascaded to all concerned personnel and that it reflects actual practice.

Objective

To ensure proper cargo handling while optimizing space and attaining maximum load factor inside the container van.


Policies

1. Utilization shall be at least: 20ft – 26cbm, 10ft – 12cbm, 40 ft – 56cbm.
2. Heavier cargoes shall be placed on the bottom portion of the container.
3. Light cargoes shall be placed on top of the heavier cargoes.

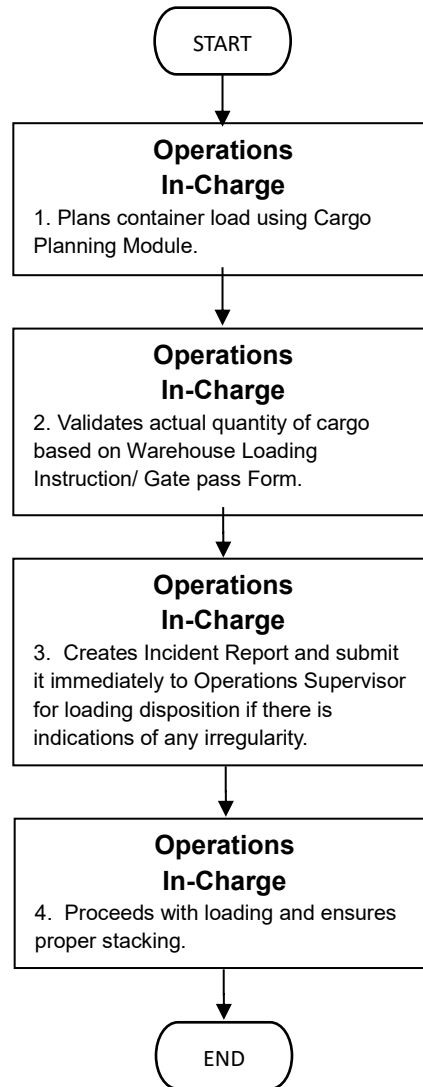
