Executive Summary Report

September 2019

Our September SHE Program started with the Drug-Free Workplace Seminar last September 2, 2019. It was attended by our employees, drivers and helpers and was facilitated by a representatives of Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency. A total of 54 participants attended from across all BUs.

This seminar is part of our program in promoting Drug-Free in our workplace.

Objective of this seminar was to increase the awareness and education of the employees on the adverse effects of dangerous drugs and to encourage all employees to lead a healthy lifestyle while at work and at home.



We also had our Annual Earthquake Seminar and Drill for 2019. It was conducted at F2 Corporate Center by representatives from the Bureau of Fire Protection last September 7, 2019 (Saturday). F2 employees were able to assemble safely in the designated area within 2 minutes and 8 seconds. Objective of the drill was to increase awareness and preparedness of employees on what to do in case of earthquake occurs.



Another training/seminar for the month was the Responsible Parenthood & Family Planning last September 14, 2019. Conducted by a representative from the Commission on Population of NEDA

The objective of this seminar aims to help couples to realize their desired timing, spacing, and number of children in accordance with their socioeconomic, emotional, and psychological capacity.

It was attended by 17 employees from various BUs.





With the current Dengue Outbreak in Paranaque, our SHE Committee, in coordination with Maxicare our HMO provider, conducted a Dengue Awareness Talk last September 21, 2019.

This is to educate F2 employees on how to prevent or how to handle in case F2 employees or their families catch the deadly disease and make themselves aware thus, they can protect themselves as well as their families.

It was attended by 27 employees.

Lastly we had the HIV Awareness Talk last September 28, 2019, which aims to increase awareness to all employees. Conducted by Love Yourself a NGO for HIV Awareness

This is a part of our program in educating employees HIV/AIDS awareness. Our program's objective is to empower and increase the awareness to participants of HIV/AIDS, its impact, management and availability of support systems. This is to encourage early testing and lifestyle changes that will thereby reduce and prevent further infection.
