i. Reason for Existence

Responsible in inspection and repair of fleet equipment in order to maintain high equipment availability and reliability.

II. Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Ensure an efficient repair and preventive maintenance for every equipment by following the standard procedures in order to meet high equipment availability and reliability:
 - a. Conduct inspection, repair and preventive maintenance of fleet equipment.
 - b. Request for parts and tools to be used during inspection, repair and preventive maintenance of equipment from Fleet Assistant/Supervisor.
 - c. Prepare Equipment Inspection Report (EIR) or relays the results to Fleet Supervisor.
- 2. All parts recovered during repair shall be properly surrendered and logged to Fleet Supervisor to ensure proper accountability.
- 3. Log any incoming and outgoing items being requested or returned to Fleet Assistant by using a logbook to ensure accountability and monitoring.
- 4. Conduct rescue repair upon equipment breakdown / accident, prepares and submits Rescue Form to ensure recording and documentation.
- 5. Secure all parts and tools issued by the Fleet Assistant / Supervisor and using the said parts and tools in an appropriate manner to avoid damage of parts and tools.
- 6. Every day, before and after the day, perform cleaning of the motor pool to ensure safe and quality workplace.
